TODAY'S GAME: Furman will face the Cougars of the College of Charleston in a 1 p.m. game at John Kresse Arena on the C of C campus in Charleston, S.C.. Today's game will not be broadcast and will not feature media timeouts.

SERIES RECORD: Today's meeting is the 20th all-time between Furman and C of C, following a 69-37 Lady Paladin victory on Jan. 17, 2004, in Timmons Arena. Furman coach Sam Dixon is 3-0 against the Cougars, while the Furman program as a whole holds a 14-5 advantage in series action. Furman is 8-1 in games played in Greenville and 5-4 in Charleston matchups. The Cougars' 37-point total against FU earlier this season stands as the fewest points the Lady Paladins have allowed in 2003-04 and the fewest Furman has given up to any opponent since allowing only 36 in a Nov. 28, 1987, game versus Erskine.

SCOUTING THE COUGARS: College of Charleston enters today's game with a 5-18 overall record and 3-13 mark in Southern Conference play. The Cougars are riding a seven-game losing streak, dating back to a Jan. 19 win over Wofford. Patrice Bryant is the Cougars' leading scorer though Carrie Geden led the College of Charleston in its earlier game with Furman, scoring 10, while Bryant contributed five and Tiffany Green added nine. Also in that game Furman's Orion Wake scored 13 with 10 rebounds, while Jen Nadalin totaled 12 points and Mivvi Strickland contributed nine. Strickland and Wake also claimed two blocks apiece in that game.

20-WIN SEASON WITHIN REACH: If Furman can win out in the regular season and take at least one victory in the Southern Conference Tournament, the Lady Paladins will have their first 20-win season since 1999-00, when Furman won the SoCon Tournament and posted a 20-11 overall mark. Furman's only other 20-win season came in 1989-90.

ROAD SWING: Today's game at College of Charleston marks the first of three consecutive road games for the Lady Paladins. In addition to the C of C game, Furman will play Georgia Southern on Monday in Statesboro and Western Carolina next Saturday in Cullowhee, N.C. Furman ends the regular season with a pair of home games against Davidson and Elon.

BREAK EVEN GAME/30TH WIN: Furman's 74-62 victory over Appalachian State on Saturday guaranteed the Lady Paladins at least a .500 season and marked the 30th career win by Furman coach Sam Dixon, now in his second season at the helm of the Lady Paladin program.

BLOWOUT VICTORY: After losing 63-60 to UNC Greensboro on Jan. 3, 2004, the Lady Paladins rebounded to take an 89-42 decision on Jan. 31. The 47-point victory was the largest of Sam Dixon's career here at Furman and was the Lady Paladins' biggest victory since a 51-point, 98-47 win over Winthrop on Jan. 30, 1991. It was also Furman's biggest conference win in 19 years of competition in the Southern Conference.

LAST TIME OUT: Jen Nadalin recorded her second double-double of the season to lead the Lady Paladins to a 74-62 victory over Appalachian State. The win was Furman's fifth in a row and was the 30th of coach Sam Dixon's career. In addition to Nadalin's 15-point, 11 rebound, five steal effort, Deshara Shealey added 15 points and five assists, while Kim Lawrence added 10 points and four steals.

CHANGES COMING ON: Furman has posted victories in 10 of its last 12 games. Compared to the first 10 games, in which the Lady Paladins posted a 4-6 record, Furman is rebounding better (42.9 to 44.4), and turning the ball over less (22.5 to 16.4). The most startling number has to do with the Lady Paladin defense, however, which gave up 66.7 points per game in the first 10 contests, and has given up a stingy 51.5 per game in the last 12.

OFFENSIVE MINDED: Lately junior forward Jen Nadalin has become an offensive powerhouse for Furman. In the first 13 games of the season Nadalin averaged 7.1 points and 4.8 rebounds per game with a .402 shooting percentage from the field. In the last nine games, however, Nadalin has scored in double figures seven times and is leading the Lady Paladins with an 11.8 points per game average and 7.3 rebounds per game mark and is shooting .563 from the field.

MOVING ON UP: Senior center Orion Wake has recorded a doubledouble in five of the last 12 games, and with 12 rebounds against UTC entered the Lady Paladin top five. Wake totals 766 rebounds entering the game with College of Charleston, which ranks fifth on the Lady Paladins' all-time chart, and is 25 boards away from Rhonda Chanson's fourth place total of 791. Natalie Cleckley ('91) holds the Lady Paladin record for career rebounds, with 1,102.

THE GOOD, THE BAD, THE UGLY: While Furman leads the Southern Conference statistics in steals (12.00), offensive rebounds (17.14), scoring defense (58.4), rebounding defense (35.9) and tunover margin (+3.05), the Lady Paladins are a dismal ninth in three-point percentage (.287), 10th in three-pointers made (3.32), sixth in assist/turnover ratio (0.65), and ninth in free throw percentage (.641).

IS 30 SO MUCH TO ASK?: Furman's defense is so stifling the Lady Paladins usually just need a little offense to get a "W". In fact, Furman is off to an 11-2 record this season in games in which the Lady Paladins score 30 or more first half points. When the Lady Paladins can't reach the 30 mark by the break the record falls to 3-6.

WRITING HER NAME IN THE RECORD BOOKS: Senior forward Kim Lawrence scored eight points in the Lady Paladin game against Western Carolina (1/7) to become the 15th woman in school history to score 1,000 points in her career. Lawrence entered the game with the Catamounts seven points away from 1,000 and earned the coveted mark on a jump shot with 6:00 left in the game. Now Lawrence has moved into fifth on Furman's all-time steals list, with 206, and is only seven away from toppling Janice Rhynehardt, who ranks fourth all-time, with 213 takeaways.

LINEUP SHAKEDOWN: After starting the same five players the first 10 games of the year, coach Sam Dixon made a slight alteration entering the Wofford game and claimed five victories in seven games with the new lineup. Now he has made another change and is off to a 5-0 start with Roach and Lawrence at forward, Wake at center, and Paris and Shealey in the backcourt.

PRESSURE, PRESSURE: Furman full-court press and ball harrassment has forced every single opponent this season to make 15 or more turnovers. Holy Cross has the most, with 31, while UTC had the fewest, with 15. When Furman takes care of the ball and commits 15 or fewer turnovers, the Lady Paladins are 5-1.

TENACIOUS D: The Lady Paladins are giving up just 58.4 (first in the SoCon) points per game to their opponents this season. Entering today's game against C of C, the Lady Paladins are 10-2 when allowing 60 or fewer points - Furman's only missteps in this situation were a 58-48 loss to the Big East's Providence in the season opener and a 57-46 loss at Davidson.

PROPHETIC FIRST HALF: So far this season the Lady Paladins have not staged any big comebacks, but they haven't had any serious second half tanks either. In fact, Furman is 11-1 when leading at the half and 0-6 when trailing at the half. In the four games that have been tied at the break the Lady Paladins are 3-1 with the lone loss to Clemson.

BLOWOUTS ONLY, PLEASE: The Lady Paladins are a surpising 1-5 in games decided by 10 points or less. In games with a margin of 11 or more points, the Lady Paladin record improves to 13-3.

TRUTH IN NUMBERS: With a 14-8 record this season Furman's statistics in games won are easy to compare to stats in games lost. Here is a look at how the Lady Paladins look in a few major categories:

MORE ABOUT FURMAN VS. FURMAN: In games won this season senior Deshara Shealey is Furman's most productive offensive player, averaging 11.4 points per game. Kim Lawrence comes in second at 9.9 while Jen Nadalin and Tommi Paris are tied for third at 9.8. In games lost Lawrence ranks fourth, at 7.4, while Shealey is tops at 11.1 and Paris is second at 9.9. In addition, Furman is outscoring opponents in the second half 544-415 in victories, and have been outscored 291-243 in the second period in losses.

SHOOTING HELPS, BUT NOT A MUST: While every team would like to shoot 50% or better from the field in every game of the season, Furman has accomplished this feat only once in 21 games. The good news is the Lady Paladins are 9-4 when shooting between 40-49% from the field and have even won four games (4-4) when shooting less than 40%.

MONDAY, MONDAY: Some teams may have manic Mondays, but the Lady Paladins seem to enjoy the first day of the work week. In fact, Furman is a perfect 5-0 on Monday, in contrast to a dismal 0-2 when playing on Sunday. Along the same lines, the Lady Paladins are a solid 9-2 in night games (starting at or after 5 p.m.), but only 5-6 in games played earlier in the day.

SETTING THE STANDARD: Senior guard Deshara Shealey leads the league in steals at 2.64 per game and Kim Lawrence is third at 2.36. In addition, senior Orion Wake ranks second in the SoCon in rebounds (8.6), third in offensive rebounds (3.23), and is third in defensive rebounds (5.36).

BENCH BRIEFS: In the season opener at Providence, the Furman bench was led by sophomore Mivvi Strickland, who contributed six of 13 points scored by the Lady Paladin non-starters. By contrast, in game two the Furman bench contributed 43 of the Lady Paladins' 77 points. The Lady Paladins are currently 13-1 when the bench scores more than 20, while the record falls to 1-7 with a bench total of 20 or less.

NINE WITH 10: Though only Deshara Shealey (11.3) is averaging in double figure scoring for Furman, nine Lady Paladins have scored in double digits this year. In addition, seven Lady Paladins are averaging 5.0 or more points per game with Tommi Paris and Kim Lawrene both at or above 9.0.

HEAD COACH SAM DIXON: Furman coach Sam Dixon, a 1979 graduate of College of Wooster, is in his second season at the helm of the Lady Paladin program. In his first year as Furman head coach the Lady Paladins posted a 16-13 overall record with an 11-7, fourth place finish in the Southern Conference, despite a roster laden with four freshman, four sophomores, and no seniors . In addition, guard Deshara Shealey was the league's Player of the Year after averaging 14.9 points, 5.3 rebounds, and 3.83 assists per game. Prior to taking the head coaching position at Furman, Dixon was associate coach at Clemson (1999-02) and assistant coach at Arizona (1998-99).

WARMING UP: Orion Wake's 12-point performance against the Hokies of Virginia Tech was the senior center's first double digit scoring performance since scoring 10 on March 1, 2002. Wake followed up her 12 versus Virginia Tech with 10 points and 15 rebounds against the Spartans of UNC Greensboro, 12 points and 13 rebounds versus the Terriers of Wofford, and 10 points 11 rebounds against the WCU Catamounts -- giving her three consecutive double-doubles. Wake's double-double streak was broken against Appalachian State, but she doubled up again with 13 points, 10 rebounds against the College of Charleston and 13 points, 12 rebounds versus UTC.

MOP UP CREW: Furman has outrebounded 16 of 22 opponents this season and had an equal number of boards against Clemson and in the Dec. 20 UTC game. The Lady Paladin rebounding corps is led by Orion Wake, who is averaging 8.9 rebounds per game, has a team-high 69 offensive rebounds so far this season, and has led Furman on the boards in 13 games this year. The four teams that have outrebounded Furman are Georgia (#9), Virginia Tech (#15), Holy Cross, and UTC (1/24) by a grand total of 18 (5,5,5,3).

Only Janice Rhynehardt, a two-time All-Conference guard who played from 1989-92, has completed this feat in the past. Rhynehardt completed her career with 1,676 points, 449 rebounds and 327 assists. Entering the C of C game Shealey totals 328 assists, 14 away from taking over the fourth spot from Heidi White ('99).

LANEY LEADS THE WAY: Junior forward Laney Harris knocked down five three pointers in Furman's game against the Bulldogs of Gardner-Webb, four in the Lady Paladin win over Western Carolina, and two versus Appalachian State (1/10). So far this season, Furman is 4-0 when Harris hits at least two three-pointers and 12-5 when she makes at least one.

FURMAN IN SEASON OPENERS: Through the years, season openers have not been easy on the Lady Paladins, a team that has traditionally played a very tough non-conference season. Furman holds an all-time record of 13-22 in game ones, though Sam Dixon bucked that trend when he led the Lady Paladins to a 100-59 season-opening victory over Oglethorpe last year. In addition to Providence this season, the Lady Paladins of the past have inaugurated new seasons by playing South Carolina, Miami, Clemson, Alabama and Georgia, among others.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Furman owns a 57-20 (.740) record within the friendly confines of Timmons Arena - the Lady Paladin home since 1997. In 1999-00 and 2000-01, the Lady Paladins won 10 games at home in Timmons and on December 2, 2001, recorded an historic 59-57 victory over intrastate rival Clemson of the ACC.

CONFERENCE ROULETTE: Furman's Lady Paladin basketball team has played squads from seven different conferences this season. Furman played both Providence and Virginia Tech from the Big East. Opponent Gardner-Webb hails from the Atlantic Sun, while Clemson is a long-time ACC member. The Lander Bearcats play in the Peach Belt Conference, while Georgia is annual contender for the Southeastern Conference Title. Finally, the Crusaders of Holy Cross represent the Patriot League. The rest of Furman's opponents compete in the Southern Conference - the league Furmam has been a member of since 1936.

PRESEASON POLL: The Southern Conference preseason coaches' poll is in, and the Lady Paladins were picked to finish second in the league behind defending champion Chattanooga. Furman collected 85 points to Chattanooga's 99, and received one first-place vote. The poll played out as follows:

SHEALEY AS A SENIOR: Reigning 2003 Southern Conference Player of the Year Deshara Shealey is back for her senior season with the Lady Paladins. Already chosen as the league's preseason Player of the Year for 2004, Shealey is a big play maker with good passing skills, outstanding athleticism and a great work ethic. Shealey's career highs include 33 points versus Ohio (11-21-01), 13 rebounds against the College of Charleston (1-22-02), seven assists on four occasions and four steals on seven occasions. Last year Shealey hit a shot against Virginia with .3 seconds on the clock, giving the Lady Paladins a 58-56 road victory over the Cavaliers.

WAKE UP CALL: Furman senior Orion Wake is back after redshirting during the 2002-03 season. Wake, a 6-2 center from Woodbridge, Va., played in all 29 games during the 2001-02 season, averaging 10.6 points and 9.0 rebounds. A first-team all-conference selection that year, Wake was also named Southern Conference Player of the Week on Jan. 15, 2002, after averaging 17.3 points and 12.0 rebounds in games the previous week. Wake enters the 2003-04 season with career highs of 26 points at Georgia Southern (1-14-02), 14 rebounds versus ETSU (3-4-00) and Appalachian State (2-2-02), and three steals and three blocks.

LADY PALADIN LINEAGE: The Lady Paladin varsity basketball team played its first season of competition in 1969-70, posting an 8-2 record under head coach Virginia Robertson. In 34 years of competition, the Furman women's basketball program has posted a 385-407 record with 15 winning seasons, and a 13-21 record in season openers. During these years Furman women's basketball players have earned 29 all-conference citations (coaches), five SoCon Freshman of the Year Awards, five SoCon Player of the Year plaques, and one Freshman All-America award. In addition, the Lady Paladins have won four Southern Conference Championships, two league tournament titles, and earned two bids to the NCAA Tournament (1995 and 2000).
