## TONIGHT'S GAME

Tonight's game is the second between Furman and College of Charleston this season. The Lady Paladins earned a 73-55 victory in Timmons Arena on Dec. 1, 1998, and will look to complete the sweep tonight. The last College of Charleston game was unique in that the Cougars broke a 26-game double-digit scoring streak by Heidi White and that it was the last time junior Jackie Smith was held to single digit points (9). The team was led by Tara Charles and Kena Hodges, each of whom scored 11. Hodges and Smith shared rebounding honors with seven each, while Smith and Charles each dished off a team-high five assists. The Lady Paladin outrebounded the Cougars 31-26 and turned the ball over just 18 times to the Cougars' 31. College of Charleston was led by Missy Peterson who tallied 25 points on 12-of-12 shooting from the line, five-of-six from the field, and three-of-six from three point range. She was the only Cougar in double digits. The Cougars enter tonight's game having defeated Appalachian State and Wofford in the SoCon. C of C is led by senior Missy Peterson, who is averaging 18.4 points and 3.6 rebounds per game, and is ranked second in the Southern Conference in scoring behind Furman's Jackie Smith.

# HEAD COACH SHERRY CARTER

Furman head coach Sherry Carter is in her 17th year at the helm of the Lady Paladin program. Carter posts a 241-216 (.529) career mark at Furman and has four regular season Southern Conference Titles, one Southern Conference Tournament Title, an NCAA appearance, and the program's only 20-win season to her credit. In addition, Carter recruited and molded Rushia Brown, the 1992 Southern Conference Player of the Year and a current member of the WNBA's Cleveland Rockers.

- PLAYER OF THE WEEK X 3... Furman junior Jackie Smith was named Southern Conference Player of the Week for the third time this season on Tuesday, January 26. Smith averaged 32.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game in the previous week, leading the Lady Paladins to a conference victory over Georgia Southern. Earlier this season, on Dec. 22nd and Jan. 19th, Smith earned P-O-W giving her a grand total of seven Southern Conference Player of the Week awards in her career.
- •RIGHT BACK AT YOU... Sophomore Leitra Young tallied four blocks in a game for the second time this season Jan. 18th versus Chattanooga. Young's blocking average has increased from 0.5 per game in the first nine games of the year to 1.99 in the last 10. She is averaging 1.26 blocks per game for the year.
- •CHARLES IN CHARGE... Sophomore redshirt Tara Charles, the Lady Paladin point guard, has had an up and down career at Furman. Sidelined twice with back injuries (one resulted in a redshirt year) and once this season with an injured knee, Charles' playing time has been haphazard at best. When she has been on the court for the Lady Paladins, however, she has been solid, and is averaging 5.0 assists per game versus conference opponents. In addition, she has a 1.67 assist/turnover ratio against league competition and is ranked third in the league for overall assist/turnover ratio (1.33) and fifth for assists per game (versus all competition) with a 4.06 mark.
- •GONNA BE CLOSE... Senior guard Heidi White needs 55 more three pointers to break the school record for career threes, set by Karen Stanley from 1991-95. Furman is guaranteed eight more games, but would play 10 with two wins in the SoCon Tournament. If only eight games are left, White needs to average 6.8 threes per game, but if FU goes at least 10, a 5.5 average would garner her the record.
- •ITS GOOD TO BE KING... Sophomore guard Amy King as scored in double digits seven times this season, helping the Lady Paladins to a 6-1 record in those games. The only time King managed double-digit scoring in a Furman loss was Dec. 28 against Tulane.
- •LAST GAME... Furman dropped a 79-67 decision to East Tennessee State in Johnson City, Tenn., to fall to 7-4 in Southern Conference play. The Lady Paladins had a bad shooting night and connected on just 36% of field goals while giving up 49.2% shooting to the Bucs. Jackie Smith scored 25 and Heidi White added 19, but they were the only Lady Paladins in double digits. In addition, the Bucs beat Furman on the boards, outrebounding the Lady Paladins 46-35.
- •TAKE CARE OF THE BALL... Furman is currently averaging 20.1 turnovers per game, having topped the 20-turnover mark eight times this year. Not surprisingly, the Lady Paladin record in games with more than 20 turnovers is 2-6, while the record with less than or equal to 20 is 8-3. Furman's low for the year was 13 versus Wake Forest and the high was 30 against Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Furman's only losses with less than 20 turnovers were to Clemson, Colorado State, and ETSU.
- •OFFENSIVE BOARDS... The Lady Paladins wiped the boards clean in their 70-58 victory over Georgia Southern on Saturday, Jan. 23, ourebounding the Eagles by 23, 45-22. In addition, Furman claimed 16 offensive boards to Georgia Southern's seven and gave up zero offensive rebounds in the first half.
- •WHOLE LOTTA DOUBLES... Against the Catamounts of Western Carolina, five members of the Lady Paladin team scored in double digits. It was the first time five Lady Paladins reached double digits in one game since February 27, 1998, in an 85-74 Furman win over East Tennessee State in the quarterfinals of the Southern Conference Tournament.
- •CAREER BEST... Junior guard Karen Hartman set two personal bests in the Jan. 2 game against Western Carolina. Hartman tallied a career-best 10 points while playing a career-long 32 minutes. Hartman was four-of-seven from the field, one -of-two from three point range, and one-of-two from the line with two rebounds, one assist and three steals. Hartman was starting in place of injured point guard Tara Charles.
- •TWO FOR ONE... When senior Heidi White reached 1,000 career points in the Jan. 18 game at Chattanooga, it was just the second time in Lady Paladin history that two players have reached the 1,000-point milestone in the same season (Jackie Smith reached 1,000 versus Wake Forest). The last time this feat was accomplished was 1995, when Karen Stanley and Kristi Creamer each scored 1,000 career points. That was also the last time Furman advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- **LEADING THE LEAGUE...** Furman junior Jackie Smith is again leading the league in scoring (21.1), rebounding (8.7), and offensive rebounds (4.2). In addition, Smith is ranks sixth in field goal percentage (.536), third in blocks (1.18), seventh in free throw percentage (.797), 10th in assists (3.00), eighth in assist/turnover ration (0.98), and fifth in defensive rebounds (4.53). Smith also leads the Furman team in scoring, rebounding, three-point percentage (min. 10 att.), and free throw percentage, and is second in blocks.

- •OTHER LEAGUE RANKINGS... In addition to Smith's ranking in nine league categories, Furman's Heidi White ranks in four, Tara Charles and Kena Hodges are in two, and Leitra Young is in one. White is 12th in scoring (12.9), third in assists (4.53), ninth in steals (2.00), and 10th in three-pointers made (1.41), while Charles is fifth in assists (4.15) and second in assist/turnover ratio (1.42). Hodges is fourth in blocked shots (1.12) and ninth in rebounding (6.2), while Young ranks second in the league in blocks with a 1.29 mark.
- •IN THE NATION... Furman junior Jackie Smith, the reigning Southern Conference Player of the Year, rose from 22nd to 17th last week in the NCAA Division I scoring statistics, with a 21.1 points per game mark as of Jan. 18 (before the UTC game). Smith is now up to 21.7 ppg and should continue to move up the rankings chart.
- •STREAKIN AGAIN... After breaking a 26 game double-digit scoring streak earlier this season versus Coll. of Charleston, senior Heidi White is streakin' again having scored in double figures in the last nine consecutive games. Junior Jackie Smith has scored in double figures the last 14 games.
- •FIRST SHUTOUT... When Kena Hodges scored zero points versus ASU it was the 6-2 sophomore first shutout of the season and only fourth of her career. Hodges was last kept scoreless on December 30, 1997, in a 77-53 victory over UMBC.
- •SHE'S A DISH... Senior Heidi White has been brilliant off the pass the last few games. In fact, White enters today's game having dished off an average of 5.6 assists per game over the last 12 contests. In addition, against Western Carolina on January 2nd White tied her career mark of 10 assists, set December 30, 1997, against UMBC. White is averaging 4.5 assists per game for the year.
- •1,000 AND COUNTING... Entering the Dec. 17 game against Wake Forest junior forward/guard Jackie Smith needed 31 points to become the 12th woman in Furman history to score 1,000 in her career. Against the Demon Deacons Smith went 11-for-18 from the field, two-for-seven from three point range, and sank seven-of-eight free throws to score exactly 31 points. Smith enters today's game with 1,245 points. Smith also set the school record for career free throws against MTSU on Dec. 29, and currently totals 463 made free throws.
- A CAREER DAY... Furman junior and current Southern Conference Player of the Year Jackie Smith tied the school record for points in a game on Nov. 22 versus Middle Tennessee State with 37. Smith was 10-for-16 overall, two-for-two from three point range, and 15-for-18 from the line. In addition, she claimed a team-high 16 rebounds for the 23rd double-double of her career.
- ON PACE... With a little luck and no injuries, Jackie Smith could become the third woman in Furman history to score more than 1,000 career points and claim 1,000 career rebounds. Only two former Lady Paladins Natalie Cleckley and Rushia Brown have joined both the 1,000-points and 1,000-rebounds clubs. Smith currently totals 625 career rebounds.
- •JUST ONE MORE... Junior Jackie Smith has tied the school record with 15 free throws in a game four times in her career. Prior to Smith's tenure the 15-free throw record was set by Jenny White in 1977. Current Furman coach Tonya Bristow tied the record in 1996 versus Western Carolina, but Smith has tied it on four occasions, including the Nov. 22nd game versus Middle Tennessee.
- •HOW ABOUT THE REBOUND RECORD... Since Smith has tied the school mark for points and free throws in a game, it's time for her to go for the rebound mark. Smith set her career high with 19 rebounds against East Tennessee State on Jan. 31, 1998. The school mark for rebounds in a game is 23, however, and was set in January of 1991 by Natalie Cleckley.
- ON THE DOTTED LINE... Furman signed three players to National Letters of Intent in the early signing period.
- •Ashley Shipp, a 5-11 forward from Ft. Walton Beach, Florida averaged 18.9 points and 7.0 rebounds as a freshman at Okaloosa-Walton Community College last season... Named Honorable Mention All-America by Street and Smith... Three time All-State selection at Page High School.
- **Orion Wake**, a 6-2 center from Woodbridge Senior High School in Woodbridge, Virginia... Listed in top 150 players in the nation and Honorable Mention All-America by *Street and Smith*... Named All-District and All-Region as a junior... Averaged 13.2 points and 10.4 rebound last season.
- •Wendy Jones, a 5-6 point guard from Dutch Fork High School in Irmo, South Carolina... Averaged 21.0 points and 7.0 assists per game as a junior... Listed as top 50 player in *Hoops of the South...* Named all-area.
- •DOUBLE DUTY... Furman junior Jackie Smith recorded 18 double-doubles last season. Her total broke the record for double-doubles in a season (14) set by Rushia Brown in 1993-94. In addition, Smith has 28 double-doubles for her career (seven so far this season): the record of 48 is held by current WNBA player Rushia Brown.


