**Noting the Lady Paladins**

• **A CAREER DAY...** Furman junior and current Southern Conference Player of the Year Jackie Smith tied the school record for points in a game versus Middle Tennessee State with 37. Smith was 10-for-16 overall, two-for-two from three point range, and 15-for-18 from the line. In addition, she claimed a team-high 16 rebounds for the 22nd double-double of her career.

• **LAST GAME...** Furman's defense didn't show up for the first half of the game against MTSU and it showed. The Raiders scored 52 points in the first period, including a nine-for-16 showing from the three point line. Down 52-33 at the half, the Lady Paladins came out in the second period and held Middle Tennessee to 29 points while scoring 42 of their own. It was not enough to overcome the early deficit, however, and the Lady Paladins fell to 0-2 on the year with an 81-75 decision.

• **BACK AGAIN...** Furman returns two starters and six letterwinners from last year's team that went 16-13 overall and 11-5 in the Southern Conference. Furman's returning starters include Southern Conference Player of the Year (and preseason '98-'99 pick) Jackie Smith and senior Heidi White. Smith averaged 18.8 points and 10.4 rebounds a year ago to lead the Southern Conference in both categories, while Heidi White enters today's game with a 24-game double-digit scoring streak intact.

• **THE DISH...** Junior guard Heidi White recorded more assists in the 1997-98 season, than in her two previous years combined. White entered the 1997-98 season with 111 career assists, and dished off 112 last season to rank ninth on Furman's all-time list with 223.

• **ON PACE...** With a little luck and no injuries, Jackie Smith could become the third woman in Furman history to score more than 1,000 career points and claim 1,000 career rebounds. Only two former Lady Paladins - Natalie Cleckley and Rushia Brown - have joined both the 1,000-points and 1,000-rebounds clubs.

• **CLOSE TO 1,000...** Junior Jackie Smith is just 122 points away from the 1,000 mark. Smith scored 284 points as a freshman and 545 as a sophomore to tally 829 entering the 1998-99 season. If she follows her scoring pace of last season (18.8 ppg), Smith will reach the 1,000 points mark on either December 21 at Georgia Southern, or December 28 against Tulane. Her 37 point showing against MTSU upped her average so far this season to 24.5 points per game.

• **BUILDING A REPERTOIRE:** After going four-for-24 from three point range in her first two seasons, junior Jackie Smith has apparently figured out the three-point thing. The 6-1 forward popped two-of-two from outside the arc in Furman's 81-75 loss to Middle Tennessee State.

## NOTING THE LADY PALADINS

•**JUST ONE MORE...** Junior Jackie Smith has tied the school record with 15 free throws in a game four times in her career. Prior to Smith's tenure the 15-free throw record was set by Jenny White in 1977. Current Furman coach Tonya Bristow tied the record in 1996 versus Western Carolina, but Smith has tied it on four occasions, including Sunday's game versus Middle Tennessee.

•**HOW ABOUT THE REBOUND RECORD...** Since Smith has tied the school mark for points and free throws in a game, its time for her to go for the rebound mark. Smith set her career high with 19 rebounds against East Tennessee State on January 31, 1998. The school mark for rebounds in a game is 23, however, and was set in January of 1991 by Natalie Cleckley.

•**BACK ON THE BENCH...** After spending the summer as a guard for the WNBA's Washington Mystics, Furman assistant coach Adrienne Shuler is back on the bench. Don't expect her to stick around, however, Shuler plans to play again next year. Her celebrity is certainly extending beyond the '98 season -- on November 7 Shuler, along with Star Jones, Ysaye Barnwell, Mrs. Colin Powell, and others, was a "celebrity reader" at a Multi-Cultural Children's Book Festival at the Kennedy Center and will be Grand Marshal of the Bowman (S.C.) Christmas Parade on Thursday, December 10.

•**PRESEASON...** Furman's Lady Paladin team won both preseason exhibition games with point totals over 100. The Lady Paladins topped the Denmark National Team 101-55 and defeated the Low Country All Stars 105-72. Sophomore Amy King led Lady Paladin scoring in the preseason with 36 total points and an 18.0 per game average, while Jackie Smith averaged 15.5 points and a team-high 12.5 rebounds per

game. Senior Heidi White averaged 17.0 points, while freshman Elizabeth Fleming led Furman from three point range with four-for-six (.667) shooting.

•**UP NEXT:** After the Colorado State Rocky Mountain Invitational the Lady Paladins will open their home schedule with a December 1 game against College of Charleston. Furman then hosts East Tennessee State on the fifth and UNC Charlotte on the eighth.

•**DOUBLE DUTY...** Furman junior Jackie Smith recorded 18 double-doubles last season. Her total broke the record for double-doubles in a season (14) set by Rushia Brown in 1993-94. In addition, Smith has 22 double-doubles for her career: the record of 48 is held by Rushia Brown.

•**ON THE DOTTED LINE...** Furman signed three players to National Letters of Intent in the early signing period.

•**Ashley Shipp**, a 5-11 forward from Ft. Walton Beach, Florida averaged 18.9 points and 7.0 rebounds as a freshman at Okaloosa-Walton Community College last season... Named Honorable Mention All-America by Street and Smith... Three time All-State selection at Page High School.

•**Orion Wake**, a 6-2 center from Woodbridge Senior High School in Woodbridge, Virginia... Listed in top 150 players in the nation and Honorable Mention All-America by *Street and Smith*... Named All-District and All-Region as a junior... Averaged 13.2 points and 10.4 rebound last season.

•**Wendy Jones**, a 5-6 point guard from Dutch Fork High School in Irmo, South Carolina... Averaged 21.0 points and 7.0 assists per game as a junior... Listed as top 50 player in *Hoops of the South*... Named all-area.

•**MORE ON THE SERIES...** Furman has never faced any of the three teams in this tournament.

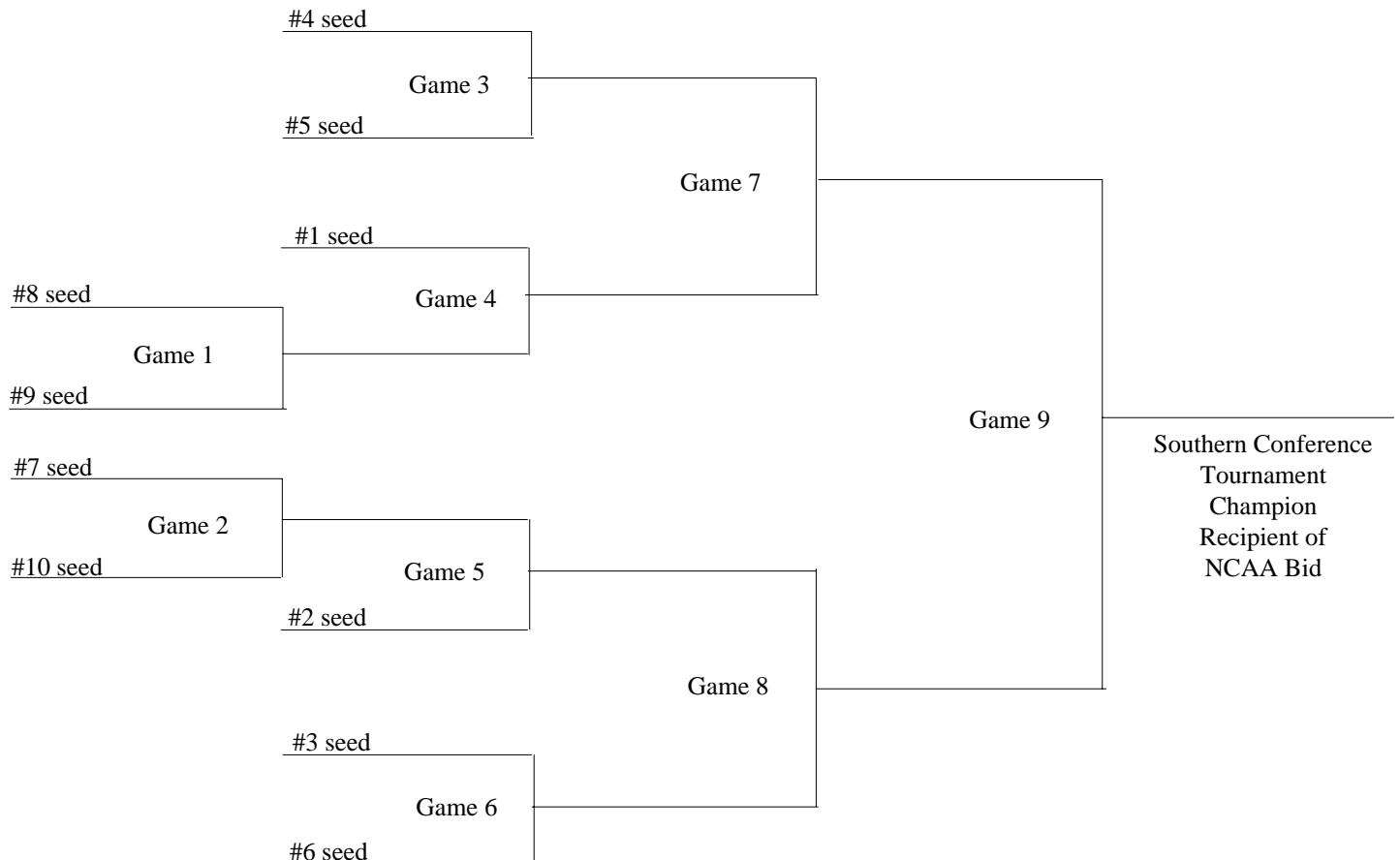
