TODAY'S GAME

Today's game is the second between these two programs this season. Furman defeated Georgia Southern 84-74 in Statesboro in the last game before Christmas break. It was Furman's first-ever victory in Statesboro. Jackie Smith led the Lady Paladin effort with 26 points, while Kena Hodges added 18, Amy King scored 16, and Heidi White tallied 13. Hodges and Smith shared rebounding honors with nine each. Despite the win, Furman was a long way from shutting down GSU's Sharon Mitchell. The 6-0, junior, forward totaled 30 points and a team-high eight rebounds, but Tondra Warren was the only other Eagle in double figures (14). Furman turned the ball over just 16 times versus the Eagles -- the Lady Paladins' second lowest turnover total of the year. In addition, Furman shot 50% from the field and 80.6% from the free throw line. Perhaps most telling, the Lady Paladins outrebounded GSU 37-28. East Tennessee State is the only other SoCon team to defeat Georgia Southern so far this season. The Lady Paladins have dropped conference decisions to Appalachian State, Davidson, and UNCG.

HEAD COACH SHERRY CARTER

Furman head coach Sherry Carter is in her 17th year at the helm of the Lady Paladin program. Carter posts a 240-215 (.527) career mark at Furman and has four regular season Southern Conference Titles, one Southern Conference Tournament Title, an NCAA appearance, and the program's only 20-win season to her credit. In addition, Carter recruited and molded Rushia Brown, the 1992 Southern Conference Player of the Year and a current member of the WNBA's Cleveland Rockers.

• **PLAYER OF THE WEEK X 2...** Furman junior Jackie Smith was named Southern Conference Player of the Week for the second time this season on Tuesday, January 19. Smith averaged 24.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game in the previous week, leading the Lady Paladins to a pair of conference wins. Earlier this season, on Tuesday, December 22nd, Smith earned P-O-W after averaging 28.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists, 1.0 steals, and 0.5 blocks for the week in wins over Wake Forest and Georgia Southern. Smith has received Player of the Week laurels six times in her career.

• **THE BIG EASY...** Junior guard/forward Jackie Smith was named to the Tulane Invitational All-Tournament Team after averaging 21.0 points, 9.5 rebounds, and 5.0 assists in two games, December 28-29, in New Orleans.

• **RIGHT BACK AT YOU...** Sophomore Leitra Young tallied four blocks in a game for the second time this season Monday night versus Chattanooga. Young's blocking average has increased from 0.5 per game in the first nine games of the year to 2.12 in the last eight. She is averaging 1.29 blocks per game for the year.

• **CHARLES IN CHARGE...** Sophomore redshirt Tara Charles, the Lady Paladin point guard, has had an up and down career at Furman. Sidelined twice with back injuries (one resulted in a redshirt year) and once this season with an injured knee, Charles' playing time has been haphazard at best. When she has been on the court for the Lady Paladins, however, she has been solid, and is averaging 5.4 assists per game versus conference opponents. In addition, she has a 1.72 assist/turnover ratio against league competition and is ranked third in the league for overall assist/turnover ratio (1.33) and fifth for assists per game (versus all competition) with a 4.00 mark.

• **LAST GAME...** The Lady Paladins won their second consecutive game with a 78-70 decision on the road at Chattanooga. Heidi White scored the 1,000th point of her career and dished off her 300th assist in the win, while Jackie Smith led the team with 28 points and 14 rebounds -- her sixth double-double of the year. Furman shot 40.9% from the field and 77.8% from the free throw line and outrebounded the Mocs 46-37.

• **TAKE CARE OF THE BALL...** Furman is currently averaging 20.4 turnovers per game, having topped the 20-turnover mark eight times this year. Not surprisingly, the Lady Paladin record in games with more than 20 turnovers is 2-6, while the record with less than 20 is 7-2. Furman's low for the year was 13 versus Wake Forest and the high was 30 against Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Furman's only losses with less than 20 turnovers were to Clemson and Colorado State.

• **OFFENSIVE BOARDS...** When comparing Furman's cumulative statistics to those of their opponents a few categories stand out. While Furman has out-blocked opponents 72-33 this season, the Lady Paladins have had the ball stolen more times than they have stolen the ball (128-192). In addition, Furman has been outrebounded in the offensive category 265-229. If the opponents scored two points on each of those extra chances it adds up to 72 points scored by the opponents -- and 72 points not scored by Furman.

• **WHOLE LOTTA DOUBLES...** Against the Catamounts of Western Carolina, five members of the Lady Paladin team scored in double digits. It was the first time five Lady Paladins reached double digits in one game since February 27, 1998, in an 85-74 Furman win over East Tennessee State in the quarterfinals of the Southern Conference Tournament.

• **CAREER BEST...** Junior guard Karen Hartman set two personal bests in the January 2 game against Western Carolina. Hartman tallied a career-best 10 points while playing a career-long 32 minutes. Hartman was four-of-seven from the field, one -of-two from three point range, and one-of-two from the line with two rebounds, one assist and three steals. Hartman was starting in place of injured point guard Tara Charles.

• **TWO FOR ONE...** When senior Heidi White reached 1,000 career points in the January 18 game at Chattanooga, it was just the second time in Lady Paladin history that two players have reached the 1,000-point milestone in the same season (Jackie Smith reached 1,000 versus Wake Forest). The last time this feat was accomplished was 1995, when Karen Stanley and Kristi Creamer each scored 1,000 career points. That was also the last time Furman advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

• **LEADING THE LEAGUE...** Furman junior Jackie Smith is again leading the league in scoring (21.1), rebounding (8.7), and offensive rebounds (4.0). In addition, Smith is ranks sixth in field goal percentage (.534), second in blocks (1.25), eighth in free throw percentage (.791), 10th in assists (3.13), and fifth in defensive rebounds (4.38). Smith also leads the Furman team in scoring, rebounding, three-point percentage (min. 10 att.), and free throw percentage, and is second in blocks.

•**IN THE NATION...** Furman junior Jackie Smith, the reigning Southern Conference Player of the Year, rose from 22nd to 17th this week in the NCAA Division I scoring statistics, with a 21.1 points per game mark as of January 18 (before the UTC game).

•**STREAKIN AGAIN...** After breaking a 26 game double-digit scoring streak earlier this season versus College of Charleston, senior Heidi White is streakin' again having scored in double figures in the last seven consecutive games, and seven of the last eight. Junior Jackie Smith has scored in double figures the last 12 games.

•**FIRST SHUTOUT...** When Kena Hodges scored zero points versus ASU it was the 6-2 sophomore first shutout of the season and only fourth of her career. Hodges was last kept scoreless on December 30, 1997, in a 77-53 victory over UMBC.

•**SHE'S A DISH...** Senior Heidi White has been brilliant off the pass the last few games. In fact, White enters today's game having dished off an average of 5.8 assists per game over the last eight contests. In addition, against Western Carolina on January 2nd White tied her career mark of 10 assists, set December 30, 1997, against UMBC.

•**1,000 AND COUNTING...** Entering the December 17 game against Wake Forest junior forward/guard Jackie Smith needed 31 points to become the 12th woman in Furman history to score 1,000 in her career. Against the Demon Deacons Smith went 11-for-18 from the field, two-for-seven from three point range, and sank seven-of-eight free throws to score exactly 31 points. Smith enters today's game with 1,188 points. Smith also set the school record for career free throws against MTSU on December 29. Smith currently totals 442 made free throws, 53 more than the 389 tallied by Lauren Reed from 1981-85.

• **A CAREER DAY...** Furman junior and current Southern Conference Player of the Year Jackie Smith tied the school record for points in a game on November 22 versus Middle Tennessee State with 37. Smith was 10-for-16 overall, two-for-two from three point range, and 15-for-18 from the line. In addition, she claimed a team-high 16 rebounds for the 23rd double-double of her career.

• **ON PACE...** With a little luck and no injuries, Jackie Smith could become the third woman in Furman history to score more than 1,000 career points and claim 1,000 career rebounds. Only two former Lady Paladins - Natalie Cleckley and Rushia Brown - have joined both the 1,000-points and 1,000-rebounds clubs. Smith currently totals 608 career rebounds.

•**JUST ONE MORE...** Junior Jackie Smith has tied the school record with 15 free throws in a game four times in her career. Prior to Smith's tenure the 15-free throw record was set by Jenny White in 1977. Current Furman coach Tonya Bristow tied the record in 1996 versus Western Carolina, but Smith has tied it on four occasions, including the Nov. 22nd game versus Middle Tennessee.

•**HOW ABOUT THE REBOUND RECORD...** Since Smith has tied the school mark for points and free throws in a game, it's time for her to go for the rebound mark. Smith set her career high with 19 rebounds against East Tennessee State on January 31, 1998. The school mark for rebounds in a game is 23, however, and was set in January of 1991 by Natalie Cleckley.

•**UP NEXT:** The Lady Paladins head to Charleston on January 29 for a 7 p.m. game versus the Cougars of C of C. Furman defeated Charleston 73-55 in Timmons Arena on December 1, 1998.

•**ON THE DOTTED LINE...** Furman signed three players to National Letters of Intent in the early signing period.

•**Ashley Shipp**, a 5-11 forward from Ft. Walton Beach, Florida averaged 18.9 points and 7.0 rebounds as a freshman at Okaloosa-Walton Community College last season... Named Honorable Mention All-America by Street and Smith... Three time All-State selection at Page High School.

•**Orion Wake**, a 6-2 center from Woodbridge Senior High School in Woodbridge, Virginia... Listed in top 150 players in the nation and Honorable Mention All-America by *Street and Smith*... Named All-District and All-Region as a junior... Averaged 13.2 points and 10.4 rebound last season.

•**Wendy Jones**, a 5-6 point guard from Dutch Fork High School in Irmo, South Carolina... Averaged 21.0 points and 7.0 assists per game as a junior... Listed as top 50 player in *Hoops of the South*... Named all-area.

•**DOUBLE DUTY...** Furman junior Jackie Smith recorded 18 double-doubles last season. Her total broke the record for double-doubles in a season (14) set by Rushia Brown in 1993-94. In addition, Smith has 27 double-doubles for her career (six so far this season): the record of 48 is held by current WNBA player Rushia Brown.

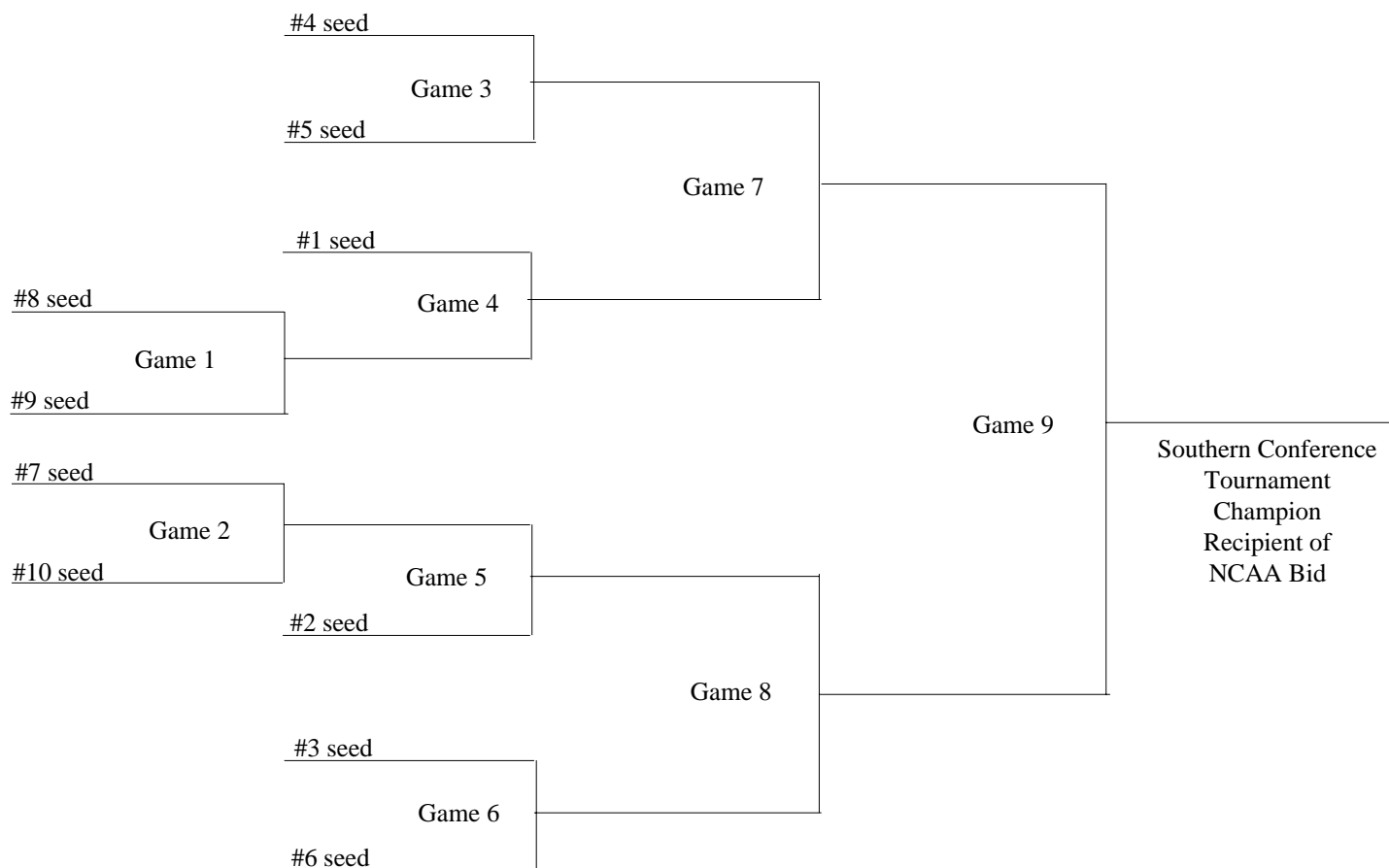
