TODAY'S GAME

Today's game is the third this year between the Wildcats of Davidson and the Furman Lady Paladins, but is the first-ever meeting at the Southern Conference Tournament between these two programs. On Jan. 11, the Wildcats defeated Furman 88-71 in Davidson despite a 17-point, nine-rebound effort by Jackie Smith. Davidson topped the Lady Paladins 85-71 in Greenville even though Furman led 36-34 at the half, and sophomore Kena Hodges scored a career-high 25 points. In the two games so far this year, Jamie Brown has led Davidson's efforts with 21 points and 19 points, respectively, while Smith and Hodges have been in double digits twice for the Lady Paladins. Despite Furman's 17-6 series record against the Wildcats, Davidson has won the last three meetings.

HEAD COACH SHERRY CARTER

Furman head coach Sherry Carter is in her 17th year at the helm of the Lady Paladin program. Carter posts a 244-219 (.527) career mark at Furman and has four regular season Southern Conference Titles, one Southern Conference Tournament Title, an NCAA appearance, and the program's only 20-win season to her credit. In addition, Carter recruited and molded Rushia Brown, the 1992 Southern Conference Player of the Year and a current member of the WNBA's Cleveland Rockers.

• **RARE STOPPAGE...** In the Feb. 13 game against Davidson, junior Jackie Smith went 0-for-1 from the line, marking the first time since Feb. 10, 1998, that she played a game without making a single free throw. In that Feb. 10 game a year ago, UNCG held Smith to 16 points and eight rebounds without ever sending the 80.5% free throw shooter to the line. This year's Feb. 13 game against Davidson was the first time since January of her freshman year that Smith had at least one free throw attempt in a game and didn't make any.

• **PLAYER OF THE WEEK X 3...** Furman junior Jackie Smith was named Southern Conference Player of the Week for the third time this season on Tuesday, January 26. Smith averaged 32.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game in the previous week, leading the Lady Paladins to a conference victory over Georgia Southern. Earlier this season, on Dec. 22nd and Jan. 19th, Smith earned P-O-W giving her a grand total of seven Southern Conference Player of the Week awards in her career.

• **DOUBLE DUTY...** Furman junior Jackie Smith recorded 18 double-doubles last season. Her total broke the record for double-doubles in a season (14) set by Rushia Brown in 1993-94. In addition, Smith has 32 double-doubles for her career (11 so far this season); the record of 48 is held by current WNBA player Rushia Brown.

• **CHARLES IN CHARGE...** Sophomore redshirt Tara Charles, the Lady Paladin point guard, has had an up and down career at Furman. Sidelined twice with back injuries (one resulted in a redshirt year) and once this season with an injured knee, Charles' playing time has been haphazard at best. When she has been on the court for the Lady Paladins, however, she has been solid, and is averaging 4.5 assists per game versus conference opponents. In addition, she has a 1.21 assist/turnover ratio against league competition and is ranked second in the league for overall assist/turnover ratio (1.45) and fourth for assists per game (versus all competition) with a 4.41 mark.

• **DONE IN BY DEFENSE...** They say that defense wins ballgames and Furman can't argue. The Lady Paladins are 1-11 this season when giving up more than 70 points. The lone exception was the Lady Paladins' Dec. 21 win over Georgia Southern by an 84-74 score -- Furman's highest points total of the year.

• **LINING UP...** Junior Jackie Smith set the school record for free throws in a season Saturday, Feb. 6, versus UNC Greensboro. Smith's seven against the Spartans gave her 178 for the year, two more than the record of 176 set in the 1997-98 season by none other than -- Jackie Smith. Smith has already broken the Furman record for career free throws made.

• **ITS GOOD TO BE KING...** Sophomore guard Amy King has scored in double digits 11 times this season, helping the Lady Paladins to a 9-2 record in those games. The only times King managed double-digit scoring in a Furman loss was Dec. 28 against Tulane, and Feb. 6 versus UNCG.

• **TAKE CARE OF THE BALL...** Furman is currently averaging 19.8 turnovers per game, having topped the 20-turnover mark 11 times this year. Not surprisingly, the Lady Paladin record in games with more than 20 turnovers is 3-8, while the record with less than or equal to 20 is 10-5. Furman's low for the year was 10 versus UTC in the last game of the regular season and the high was 30 against Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Furman's only losses with less than 20 turnovers were to Clemson, Colorado State, ETSU, and Wofford.

• **OFFENSIVE BOARDS...** The Lady Paladins wiped the boards clean in their 70-58 victory over Georgia Southern on Saturday, Jan. 23, rebounding the Eagles by 23, 45-22. In addition, Furman claimed 16 offensive boards to Georgia Southern's seven and gave up zero offensive rebounds in the first half.

• **TWO FOR ONE...** When senior Heidi White reached 1,000 career points in the Jan. 18 game at Chattanooga, it was just the second time in Lady Paladin history that two players have reached the 1,000-point milestone in the same season (Jackie Smith reached 1,000 versus Wake Forest). The last time this feat was accomplished was 1995, when Karen Stanley and Kristi Creamer each scored 1,000 career points. That was also the last time Furman advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

• **LEADING THE LEAGUE...** Furman junior Jackie Smith is again leading the league in scoring (20.2), rebounding (9.0), and offensive rebounds (4.23). In addition, Smith is ranked eighth in field goal percentage (.512), fifth in blocks (0.96), third in free throw percentage (.811), and second in defensive rebounds (4.77). Smith also leads the Furman team in scoring, rebounding, three-point percentage (min. 10 att.), and free throw percentage, and is third in blocks and second in steals.

In 1998-99, the Lady Paladins...

- Topped 80 points on two occasions (2-0 record)
- Scored fewer than 60 points of four occasions (0-4 record)
- Tallied five or more blocks nine times (5-4 record)
- Tallied double-digit steals six times (2-4 record)
- Tallied 20 or more assists on four occasions (3-1 record).
- Entered the Southern Conference Tournament as the fifth seed for just the second time. Furman was the fifth seed in 1990-91 and lost to Appalachian State 84-77 in the first round.

•**OTHER LEAGUE RANKINGS...** In addition to Smith's ranking in seven league categories, Furman's Heidi White ranks in five, Kena Hodges in four, Tara Charles in two, and Leitra Young is in one. White is 13th in scoring (12.7), third in assists (4.46), 10th in steals (1.85), ninth in three pointers made (1.42), and 10th in assist/turnover ratio (0.85). Hodges is eighth in rebounding (6.4), third in blocked shots (1.12), 10th in field goal percentage (.503), and ninth in offensive rebounds (2.35). Charles is fourth in assists (4.41) and second in assist/turnover ratio (1.45), while Young is second in blocks (1.15). It's no surprise that the Furman team is ranked first in the league in blocking with a 3.92 average.

•**IN THE NATION...** As of Feb. 1, Furman junior Jackie Smith, the reigning Southern Conference Player of the Year, was ranked 13th in the nation with a 21.9 points per game average. Smith currently ranks 25th with a 20.2 points per game average.

•**STREAKIN...** Junior Jackie Smith has scored in double figures the last 21 games, and has led the Lady Paladin team in scoring in 21 contests this season. Smith has also recorded double digit scoring and rebounding in seven of the last 10 games.

•**THE AWAKENING...** Though Kena Hodges has averaged a very respectable 8.9 points and 6.4 rebounds per game this season, the sophomore has been outstanding the last three games. Hodges has averaged 17.0 points and 10.7 rebounds over the last three contests.

•**SHE'S A DISH...** Senior Heidi White has moved into third on the all-time assists list with 339 in her career (eight shy of second). White has 116 for the season, making the second year in a row she has topped the 100-assists mark. White is behind only Karen Stanley (347) and all-time assists leader Lucy Dunn (428).

•**1,000 AND COUNTING...** Entering the Dec. 17 game against Wake Forest junior forward/guard Jackie Smith needed 31 points to become the 12th woman in Furman history to score 1,000 in her career. Against the Demon Deacons Smith went 11-for-18 from the field, two-for-seven from three point range, and sank seven-of-eight free throws to score exactly 31 points. Smith enters today's game with 1,353 points. Smith also set the school record for career free throws against MTSU on Dec. 29, and currently totals 507 made free throws.

•**A CAREER DAY...** Furman junior and current Southern Conference Player of the Year Jackie Smith tied the school record for points in a game on Nov. 22 versus Middle Tennessee State with 37. Smith was 10-for-16 overall, two-for-two from three point range, and 15-for-18 from the line. In addition, she claimed a team-high 16 rebounds for the 23rd double-double of her career.

•**ON PACE...** With a little luck and no injuries, Jackie Smith could become the third woman in Furman history to score more than 1,000 career points and claim 1,000 career rebounds. Only two former Lady Paladins - Natalie Cleckley and Rushia Brown - have joined both the 1,000-points and 1,000-rebounds clubs. Smith currently totals 694 career rebounds.

•**JUST ONE MORE...** Junior Jackie Smith has tied the school record with 15 free throws in a game four times in her career. Prior to Smith's tenure the 15-free throw record was set by Jenny White in 1977. Current Furman coach Tonya Bristow tied the record in 1996 versus Western Carolina, but Smith has tied it on four occasions, including the Nov. 22nd game versus Middle Tennessee.

•**ON THE DOTTED LINE...** Furman signed three players to National Letters of Intent in the early signing period.

•**Ashley Shipp**, a 5-11 forward from Ft. Walton Beach, Florida averaged 18.9 points and 7.0 rebounds as a freshman at Okaloosa-Walton Community College last season... Named Honorable Mention All-America by Street and Smith... Three time All-State selection at Page High School.

•**Orion Wake**, a 6-2 center from Woodbridge Senior High School in Woodbridge, Virginia... Listed in top 150 players in the nation and Honorable Mention All-America by *Street and Smith*... Named All-District and All-Region as a junior... Averaged 13.2 points and 10.4 rebound last season.

•**Wendy Jones**, a 5-6 point guard from Dutch Fork High School in Irmo, South Carolina... Averaged 21.0 points and 7.0 assists per game as a junior... Listed as top 50 player in *Hoops of the South*... Named all-area.
