"People of the Book"	3:113ff.	"Of the people of the book there are those who recite the revelations of God, believe in God and the last day, and enjoin right and forbid wrong, and vie with one another in good works. These are of the righteous. They will find their reward with God..."
Abraham Ishmael Isaac Jacob Moses	Q: 3:84	Say:(Muslims) We believe in what was revealed to Abraham, Isma'il, Isaac, Jacob and the tribes, and in (the books) given to Moses, Jesus, and the Prophets, from their Lord"
Moses Jesus	5:47ff	"It was We (God) who revealed the Torah to Moses; therein was guidance and light. By its standards have been judged the Jews...And in their footsteps We sent Jesus the Son of Mary, confirming the Torah that had come before him. We sent him the Gospel, therein was guidance and light, and confirmation of the Torah... Let the people of the Gospel judge by what Allah has revealed therein."
Jews Christians	2:62	Those who believe (in the Qur'an), and those who follow the Jewish (scriptures) and the Christians and the Sabians, any who believe in God and the Last Day, and work righteousness, shall have their reward with their Lord, on them shall be no fear, nor shall they grieve
Jesus	3:45-55	a word from God -- nearest to God -- born of a virgin -- healer -- resurrects the dead -- raised up by God --
Jesus	4:157ff	the Jews did not crucify Jesus
Jesus	5:116ff	Jesus never said he is the son of God
Mary	19:1ff	virgin, chaste, blessed
