Preparation for Midterm Exam

### 1. Known listening

a. For ALL the songs available on Box for Chapters 1-5:

be prepared to identify artist and title.

b. For JUST the songs in the Schloss text's Listening Guides for Chapters 1-5 (see page ix), be prepared to identify: artist, title, date of release (within 5 years), and approximately what location in the song was played (verse, chorus, "B section," etc).

### 2. Unknown listening

Be prepared to describe what you perceive to be important musical characteristics in an unknown excerpt that is played. Things you might consider: instrumentation, vocal style, lyrics, rhythm/beat, style, form, etc. Based on your description, suggest who might have recorded the excerpt.
